RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A GRANT OF FUNDS TO THE COUNTLYS OF WARREN AND WASHINGTON INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AGENCY

WHEREAS, the Agency is a body corporate and politic July organized and existing under Sections 856 and 890-c of the General Municipal Law ("OML") of the State of New York (the "State"), with principal place of business at 5 Warren Street, Glers Jalls, New York; and

WHEREAS, in January, 2014 the Corporation completed an assistance project with The Hudson Headwaters Health Network; and

WHEREAS, the Corporation received a fee for its services; and

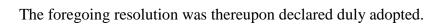
